


# The SILVER LINCS WAY

## Linking Grimsby & Louth

A 25 mile walk linking the two towns, established in 2005 to mark the Silver Jubilee of the Grimsby & Louth Group of the Ramblers.




- 17** Follow the stony track to a T junction in the woods. Turn right and follow the path through the woods.
- 18** Cross the A157 with care and continue uphill on the permissive path - available only for walkers by kind consent of the landowners. Turn left at the lane and left at the next footpath.
- 19** Where paths meet in the valley, turn right. Go through a gate and cross a field. Just before the gate, next to a road turn right and follow the hedge line in a parallel arc. Leave the field down the steps in the right hand corner.
- 20** At the road turn left under the bypass then go through a gate into Hubbard's Hills. Follow the River Lud, then the road and turn left through a gate into Westgate Fields. At the road turn right into Westgate and continue to St James' Church. - **21**.



**1** Start the walk at the roundabout in Scartho village. Walk down Waltham Road. Take the 1st right into Springfield Road. Follow the road where it becomes Lavenham Road. Go 1st right on Fallowfield Road and 1st right into Oxcombe Close.

**2** Follow the bridleway, crossing a road and continue to a T junction. Turn left and continue on the bridleway to Barnoldby le Beck.

**3** Go past the obelisk and church and down Chapel Lane. Bear right at the main road, cross at the village green and follow the footpath to Brigsley.



**4** Turn right past the ice cream shop and walk 70 yards down the road then take the path on the left across the field, bearing right at the path junction by the hedge.

**5** At the road turn left into Ashby Cum Fenby. Turn right onto Post Office Lane and continue straight ahead on the lane then the footpath.

**6** At the junction of paths turn right and then left at the next path junction.


**7** Just before the road turn left and after 90 yards take care crossing the road to rejoin the bridleway.

**8** At the next junction turn left onto a track. Follow the track round the woods. Go through the gap in the hedge, turn right and follow the bridleway to Wold Newton.

**9** Walk through the village ignoring the road and the first bridleway on the left.

**10** Take the next bridleway on the left into the wooded valley and continue ahead until you reach a road.

**11** Turn right onto the road and take the second bridleway on the left. Continue ahead through Cadeby and then Wyham.



**12** Turn left onto the road and take care when it joins the A18. Go 1st right at the next junction. Pass Utterby School and turn right to North Ormsby.

**13** Turn left into the village and follow the footpath to a path junction.

**14** Turn right then take a path left down a few steps in the bank. Ascend through the fields.

**15** Turn left at a stony track and after 400 yards turn right and descend the field to a footbridge. Cross and go right after the stile. At the next stile cross and continue through the earthworks. After 350 yards bear left and ascend to a double stile.

Cross the stiles and continue by the fence, then follow the fingerpost through the site of a mediaeval village to a gate. Bear left on the track.

**16** At the road turn right and at the T junction left. Continue to the A631 and cross it with care. Continue ahead then turn 1st left by a derelict cottage onto a bridleway.
